

Dalhousie University Summer Residence Policy re: Minors & Chaperones

Important: All persons attending the CAF 2024 Summer Camp must abide by this policy.

In Nova Scotia, a minor is anyone 18 years of age and younger. All minors must be always chaperoned by an adult 19 years and older. **The required minor/chaperone ratio is 8:1.**

Chaperones **shall ensure that** the minors are properly supervised and that all activities undertaken by the minors are safe given the relative age, skill, and experience level of the minors under their care.

All chaperones must provide their contact information when completing the CAF 2024 summer camp registration [online](#). The CAF 2024 summer camp organizers must subsequently provide the contact information for all chaperones to the university's Event & Conference Services office prior to participants' arrival. All chaperones must be available on a 24-hour basis during the summer camp.

All minors must be accompanied by a chaperone when requesting services from the front desk, such as they are locked out of their room. If a minor is looking to make changes to their room (not for a maintenance reason), it needs to be communicated to the CAF 2024 summer camp organizers (aikikaiaigonish@gmail.com) who will then inform the university's Event Manager accordingly.

The chaperones will be responsible for ensuring that the minors comply with the following terms and conditions:

- Alcoholic beverages will not be permitted in any facility unless specific arrangements are made through the Bar Services Department and are in accordance with the Liquor Control Act of Nova Scotia. Alcohol consumption is prohibited in all public areas in residence facilities.
- Smoking including tobacco, cannabis and vaping is prohibited on Dalhousie University campus this also includes all residence facilities.
- Failure to disclose planned event activities could result in an inability to service your event on-site or result in additional charges (i.e., custodial or security).
- No materials of any kind may be affixed to the ceiling or to any walls by any method whatsoever unless approved by Event & Conference Services.
- No commercial advertising is permitted on the exterior of the facility without written permission of Event & Conference Services.
- Dalhousie University does not permit any firearms/weapons on campus under any circumstances.
- Guests are required to always follow the directions of Dalhousie University Security while on campus.
- Restrictions apply on open flames in all Dalhousie University facilities. Any violation of fire regulations may result in an automatic charge to the guest's account.
- Dalhousie University is a scent free environment.
- Dalhousie University reserves the right to immediately evict any guest based on unacceptable behaviour.
- Guests or where guests are minors, **chaperones, are responsible for all damage to, and loss of Dalhousie University property (i.e., keys, conference cards).**
- Dalhousie University is not responsible for lost or stolen property.
- Pets are prohibited in residence facilities, except for certified service dogs (as per the Nova Scotia Service Dog Act).
- Under no circumstances are objects to be thrown out of a residence or facility window.
- Check in time is 3:00 pm or later.
- Check out time is 10:30 am or earlier
